**Voted** – That the Supervisor be and hereby is directed to procure a legal standard for weights and measures for this town.

**Voted** – That the Board of Supervisors of this County are hereby authorized to cause to be raised by tax on this town the ensuing year Five Hundred Dollars in addition to the sum now allowed by law to pay for constructing or repairing roads and bridges in said town.

**Voted** – That this meeting stand adjourned until the first Tuesday of April next then to be held at the public house now kept by Asa Lilly in the Village of Palmyra at 9 o'clock A. M.
