

Town of Palmyra Minutes – 1949

Regular monthly meeting of the Palmyra Town Board was called to order by Supervisor Sanford M. Young on Thursday, January 8th, 1948, at 2:00 p.m. Present: Sanford M. Young, Supervisor; Helen M. Jeffery, Town Clerk; Kingsley F. Young, Justice of the Peace; Jacob W. Crookston and Sherwood W. Mate, Town Councilmen.

The following motion was made by Kingsley F. Young, seconded by Jacob W. Crookston that Hart B. Pierce, Jr. be appointed as Justice of the Peace for a term of one year, carried.

It was regularly moved and carried that the Town Officers attend the Annual Meeting of the NYS Association of towns at Albany on February 18th-20th, 1948; and that their expenses be a town charge.

Supervisor Sanford M. Young was designated as the Palmyra Town delegate, and Highway Superintendent James DeBrine as the alternate.
